**RESOLUTION #001  
ADDENDUM #1**


Be it resolved that all golf carts and utility vehicles incapable of attaining speeds greater than twenty-five miles an hour by their manufacturer shall be allowed on the roads in Birch Creek Forest Sub-division, Burleson County, Texas with the following conditions:


1. A valid Texas Driver License holder must be on board when vehicle is using the roadway.
2. All Texas laws, i.e. stop signs, right of way, or yield, and correct side of roadway travel, will be obeyed.
3. Must display a slow moving vehicle sign.

Failure to follow these simple instructions could result in this Resolution being rescinded and/or a traffic citation.

The Board of Directors of Birch Creek Forest Properties, Inc. has the authority to rescind or reactivate this Resolution as it deems conditions require.

This ADDENDUM #1 replaces and voids the original Resolution #001 and was approved for presentation to the Burleson County Commissioners' Court by the Board of Directors of Birch Creek Forest Properties, Inc. on November 4, 2006.
